

The Committee for Accreditation of Polysomnographic Technologist Education (CoA PSG) is pleased to report that the Board of Registered Polysomnographic Technologists (BRPT) has issued a clarification of policy regarding eligibility for its examination. Bonnie Robertson, CRT, RPSGT, then President of the BRPT wrote in a letter to David Young, DO, then President of the CoA PSG:

The BRPT will consider any student who is currently enrolled in a program that successfully achieves accreditation to be immediately eligible to sit for the BRPT examination upon graduation from the program. In addition, any graduates of the same program for the previous 12 months prior to the date of the CoA PSG site visit approval letter will also become immediately eligible to sit for the BRPT examination once the program successfully achieves accreditation.
